

Typical Camp Schedule

Campers are separated by gender and grade. They are assigned to a counselor who will engage them in their activities, teach them new games and remain with them throughout the day. A typical camp schedule is as follows:

8:55-9:15: Drop off/circle time activity (Group activity one)

9:15-9:30: Announcements; flag raising

9:30-10:15: Group Activity two

10:15-10:30: Snack

10:30-11:15: Group Activity three 11:15-12:15: Zoned Activity time

12:15-1:00: Lunch

1:00-3:15: Zoned Activity time

3:15-3:30: Snack 3:45-4:00: Pick up

4:00-6:00: After Care Zoned Activity time

Age appropriate activities, organized games and sports change daily. Crafts, story time, and Fun Friday events take place weekly. A sample of the activities include: swimming, volleyball, horseshoes, shuffle board, basketball, kick ball, soccer, sand castle contests, singing and so much more.

Your camper stays with their group each day until Zoned Activity time. During Zoned Activity time your camper has the opportunity to interact with their siblings and friends from different grades. They choose which Zoned Activity in which to participate and move from activity to activity. Zoned activity time consists of organized activities and areas, each supervised by the CAMP counselors. Examples include: swim time, craft table, park play, box ball, wiffle ball and so much more.
